Dear Dr. Sears:

Thank you for your kind invitation to work with the College congregation in a Gospel meeting sometime in the future. After carefully considering my own schedule I find that the only two possible dates I could suggest would be Sunday, September 29 through Friday, October 4, 1974, and Sunday, March 17 through Friday, March 22, 1975.

You will notice that I have indicated dates for a Sunday through Friday meeting. Unfortunately, my schedule will allow for no longer periods of time to be spent in Gospel meetings unless unusual circumstances prevail. I regret that I do not have dates earlier than this but believe that should I try to crowd my schedule I would not be as effective as your work requires.

I can well understand if the elders there either do not want to schedule a meeting this far in the future or if they feel that a meeting of a longer period would be better. If I can be of help to you, I will look forward to hearing from you in the near future.


Dear Brother Chalk:
