Dear Brother Traylor:

I have just come from a conference with Brother Clois Fowler regarding our proposed meeting with the South Waco congregation. Unfortunately, the only time I have available in August would be two days, Saturday, August 5, and Sunday, August 6. I would have to fly from Memphis, Tennessee to Waco on Saturday, which would mean that we would only have Saturday afternoon and evening for services on that day. I would then have to leave Waco sometime Sunday night or Monday morning to fly back to Memphis to begin another workshop at Harding College.

I certainly want to be with you brethren down there and would make the following suggestions. Why not an area-wide youth meeting Saturday afternoon and evening, with a service to bring in the adults, if desired, on Saturday night? Then with all-day services with the church on Sunday, August 6 to complete the meeting.

I regret that there is no other time in my schedule but these two days. I would certainly understand if the brethren think this is too short a time to be with you. I would expect no further remuneration than the necessary plane fare between Memphis and Waco, round trip. Thank you so much for the kind invitation. I do regret that nothing else can be worked out this year. Please give my regards to Brother Gisk and assure him that I am in no sense of the word trying to get out of being with you. I would like nothing better. If these two days are acceptable, I will look forward to hearing from you in the near future.
