Dear Marvin:

Bill Youngs told me about his nice visit with you and had some mighty nice things to say about you. By the way, I understand that he never heard further from those of you there which would seem quite strange to me regardless of your decision.

Mrs. Blay did phone me asking if I would supply our subscription list to Herald of Truth. I told her, as you mentioned in your letter, that our Board feels that in supplying this list we take undue advantage of our subscribers, and in a way this is right. On the other hand, I feel very strongly that those of us in the church should do everything possible to pull together in every good work. This is why I suggested that we have a letter from the elders of Highland - not a letter from some person speaking for the elders when the elders know nothing about it - requesting this list for this particular purpose and none other.

Since the beginning of ACTION we have made mention of Herald of Truth many times and shown a full spirit of cooperation but this has not been the case with Highland with ACTION. Brother Cawyer, when this was mentioned to him, did send us an order for 25 copies (50¢ a month) which was a token expression of appreciation but far from what we felt should have been done.

If you wish to have these elders write ACTION in my care I will be happy to see if we can get our list of some 14,000 individual names with zip numbers to you. You will pay the cost of running this list off by our mailer and mailing. And, as I say, it is to be used for no other purpose whatsoever other than Herald of Truth and John Allen plays a very large part in this decision.
