Dear Bob:

Your recent letter requesting \$200 for special projection equipment has been considered by the Elders of this congregation. They are concerned about the loss of advertising avenues and feel that you are making the right kind of plans in connection with the scheme you suggested; however, it is impossible at this time for this congregation to give the needed amount.

This decision was based on the amount of money being spent in our present mission work, the recent decision to begin supporting the preacher at Monterey, Tennessee, a 50% increase in the 1962 budget, and a present \$380 deficit in the spending fund.

We deeply appreciate your willingness to serve Christ and sacrifice in that country. We cannot know the hardships to which you and yours are subjected. We offer up our prayers for your well-being and success in the Lord's work there.
