Dear Brother Garner:

Brother Elmer Howell has highly recommended you to the Eldership of this congregation. We are indeed deeply in sympathy with your plans to go to New Zealand to preach the gospel.

Our program at this time includes full support of R. C. Walker, Radford, Virginia, partial support of Ralph Henley in Jerusalem, and partial support of the congregation at Monterey, Tennessee. This work plus our plans for immediate expansion of physical facilities demands that we reject at this time your request for this congregation to support or sponsor your work in that land.

This is in no way a repudiation of our interest nor is it a suggestion that we will not continue to be concerned about you and your work for the Lord. Our present situation, however, demands that this decision be made.
