Dear Brother Dixon:

You will recall our correspondence during the last school year concerning a proposed trip of the Freed-Hardeman College Chorus to Cookeville. This trip, you will remember, was to include an appearance at the Broad Street building on a Tuesday night and an appearance at the Tennessee Tech assembly on Wednesday morning at 10:00. At that time, you suggested that the chorus would be available this coming spring.

I have just talked with Professor Maurice Haste, chairman of the Tennessee Tech assembly programs. Professor Haste is delighted about the possibility of the Chorus's appearance before the 3500-strong Tech student body. Professor Haste has suggested that the group appear on one of these three dates: March 20, April 3, and April 24.

The Elders of this congregation join with the entire membership in welcoming the group to appear at our building on any of the three Tuesday nights prior to the appearance at Tech. This welcome includes places to stay and proper provisions for feeding the entire group. It is our feeling that the school needs some presentation of this nature in our area at this time. We therefore urge your careful consideration of this matter and a prompt affirmative reply.
