Dear Brother Stewart:

I appreciate the invitation to be with the Mars Hill congregation in 1963 for a gospel meeting. I failed to note whether this is the right year or not but believe it to be so. I can schedule a meeting in 1963 with you to begin June 30 and continue through July 9 or to begin July 1 and continue through July 10. It would suit me much better if I could arrange to be with you for one week rather than 10 days but if the brethren there insist on a 10 day meeting you can see if the above mentioned dates are acceptable. If the meeting should begin on Sunday, June 30, I would expect to begin my part on Sunday night and end on Tuesday night, July 9. The other date would have the meeting start on Monday night, July 1, and continue through the following Wednesday night, July 10.
