This is to formally bring to your attention my desire to be no longer a member of the congregation which meets in the Jere Whitson community. I have placed membership with the Broad Street congregation. Therefore, please accept this as a letter of resignation of my work as a deacon with the Jere Whitson Road Church of Christ.

I have made this decision due to my refusal to support the teaching of the Elders and Preacher on support of Orphan Homes operated by Christians. It is my belief that the Church can support such Homes out of the treasury or use any other rightful means necessary to care for orphans.
