Dear Mr. Fahlgren:

It was a pleasure to become acquainted with you during our recent flight from Dallas to Kansas City and Minneapolis. I appreciated the opportunity of getting to know more about Panama and especially about work in connection with the foods industries of South and Central America. I do hope that you made your trip without incident and that you were able to enjoy a few days' relaxation with your relatives in Minnesota.

I told you about my work with an international radio program known as Herald of Truth. At the time of our conversation I was sure that we were on a Panama station, but our records do not so indicate. We can be heard at Pembroke, Bermuda, on Radio Station ZMB at 1:30 p.m. on Sunday afternoons. We are also heard on five different radio stations in the Philippines. The Manila station, DZAQ, carries our program at 7:30 p.m. on Sunday evenings. Any time you are in either of those areas, I would appreciate your remembering the program and possibly getting an opportunity to hear it.

Enclosed are transcripts of some of our recent radio programs that I thought you might enjoy reading. It was a pleasure to make your acquaintance. I hope that our paths cross again in the future.
