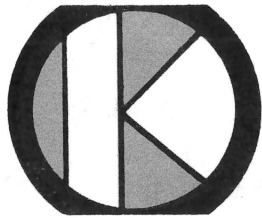

Dear John,


I just received your letter. Evidently there must have been a mix-up since I noticed you dictated it April 5th.
