Dear Ernest:

I appreciate what must have been your insistence that the elders there invite me to come for a gospel meeting. I look forward to this proposed effort and have definitely scheduled it to begin on Sunday, June 11, and continue through Friday, June 16, 1972. This is a letter of final confirmation on those proposed dates.

So far our elders here have not begun to make any contacts relative to the new preacher. The work with Herald of Truth is already becoming so burdensome that it would be a great help to me if they would have a man ready to move in the spring; but, of course, I am obligated through August, 1966. I am insisting that they visit you and in addition hope that before too long they will be making some contacts with you.
