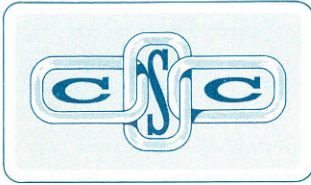

Dear Brother Chalk:

We at the Oklahoma University Bible Chair certainly appreciate the time you took out of your busy schedule to be with us in our evangelistic effort Saturday, March 16. I have heard several quite favorable comments concerning your presentation at the program that night, and we only wish that things had worked out more smoothly so that you could have done the same at the second program. I am sure that you are interested in knowing some of the results of the day. During the morning and afternoon about 1,000 OU students were contacted and as you know, we had one baptism on Saturday. There were well in excess of 100 students who indicated an interest in further study in their dorms. Many of these have been contacted and study appointments have already been made. Over 50 students requested a Bible correspondence course and about 700 copies of the Inside Story were given to OU students in one-to-one confrontations. We think that the program Saturday night was a very fitting conclusion to the effort of the day and that a great deal of good was accomplished. We think that things were learned at the program that will aid other campuses as they try the same type of approach.

We certainly want to thank you again for your part in the evangelistic effort at Oklahoma University and many of our students are looking forward to hearing you speak again. We are making plans now to bring several of them to Stillwater for one night of your meeting there. We will be praying that it will be a great success.
