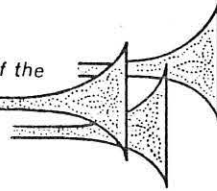

I, of course, have no further information about my final decision but I request that you pray about my doing the Lord's will, even as I pray that you will be doing His will.

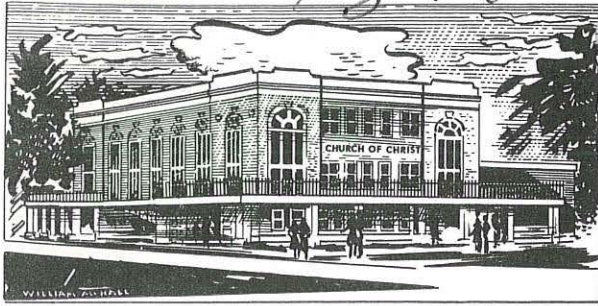
I send you my love and respect. It was great getting to be with you. The thought of having you in Atlanta is exciting.

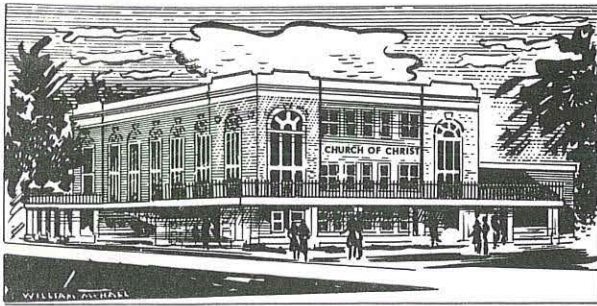
