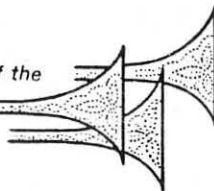

Dear Alvin:

Thank you so much for your generous and kind remarks regarding our recent 20th Century Christian issue on the Madison church. I also believe that this issue will do a great deal of good. Your personal endorsement and commendation of it is certainly a help. Thank you so much for that.

I do believe that a special issue of the Star on campus unrest would be highly acceptable. I would be especially concerned about the approach made to this problem, however. You certainly would not want to fan general prejudice of the populace against college students. Rather, you would want to specifically examine today's college student, his attitudes, and especially those ungodly influences that are shaping their thinking. These things, in turn, would need to be met by plain, Biblical teaching, as has characterized the Star from the beginning.

I think there are a number of men working today with students who would know how to pinpoint some of these problems, and how to come to some very practical approaches to meeting them. Men like Al Behel, of the University of Tennessee, Jim Bevis, who works with Campus Evangelism, William Banowsky of Pepperdine, Tim Tucker, who teaches at David Lipscomb College, Jennings Davis, Dean of Students at Pepperdine, Tom Warren, of Freed-Hardeman College, and other men involved as these are in student life and thought on both secular and Christian campuses.

I wish you the very best in an effort like this. I think it would be profitable.
