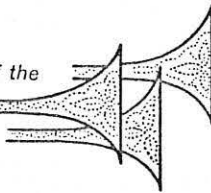


The flight back to Dallas Monday night which you mentioned earlier would not gain any time because the earliest flight to Abilene from Dallas is the same Houston to Abilene TTA #903 flight for which we have reservations. Your tickets will be mailed to you about two weeks prior to departure.

We have reserved the Clear Creek High School auditorium and have aimed our publicity to cover the Houston, Galveston, Baytown, Texas City, and surrounding areas.

The program has been planned to last approximately one and one-half hours exclusive of announcements and refreshments. Your portion of the program would consist of an appropriate lesson of your choice and a more informal (question-answer, special topic, etc.) period of your choice, the two to be separated by songs.

The young people of the Houston area are supporting these devotionals very well and we are looking forward to a most rewarding evening for the glory of Christ on the 24th of March.
