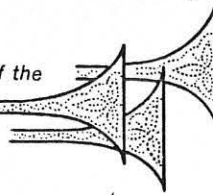

Dear Brother Chalk:


It was a pleasure to discuss with you some of the activities of Christian young people in the Houston area. We are further pleased that your commitments are such that you will be able to speak to these youth at the area wide youth devotional scheduled for March 24, 1969.

As we agreed in our phone conversation, the League City Church of Christ will compensate you in this effort with \$100.00 plus your round trip airline ticket, meals, and lodging. We will attempt to schedule airline reservations such that you will arrive and be met at the airport shortly before your speaking engagement and depart by mid-morning of the following day.
